Sub: - Admissions for the academic year 2018-19 in existing BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats at Shree Swaminarayan Homoeopathy College, Shree Swaminarayan Vishwa Mangal Gurukul Trust, Nr. Ahmedabad-Mehsana National Highway, At & PO- Saij, Kalol, Dist. Gandhinagar- 382721, Gujarat- Reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under sub regulation 3(4) of HCC (MSR), 2013, wherein, the existing college has to fulfill the minimum standard requirement of infrastructure, teaching & training facilities by 31.12.2014 for consideration of grant of permission for undertaking admission in the coming academic year. As per the provision of sub regulation 3(9) of HCC (MSR), 2013, if the existing colleges fail to achieve full compliance of the requirements as specified in the regulation by 31.12.2014 the college may be stopped for taking admission in BHMS Course. Further, as per the provision of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 2018 all Homoeopathy Medical Colleges shall seek permission of the Central Government within 01 year from the said commencement in accordance with the provisions specified in the regulations made by the Central Council.

2. In order to verify the compliance of the College, Board of governors of CCH has conducted the inspection of Shree Swaminarayan Homoeopathy College, Shree Swaminarayan Vishwa Mangal Gurukul Trust, Nr. Ahmedabad-Mehsana National Highway, At & PO- Saij, Kalol, Dist. Gandhinagar- 382721, Gujarat on 19.06.2018 for considering the Admissions for the year 2018-19.

3. The Central Government while examining the inspection report and recommendation of Board of governors of CCH in terms of the provisions of HCC (MSR), 2013 has observed that the college is not fulfilling the following basic eligibility conditions:-

- i. Preparation room, space for sterilized linen and Surgeon room is not available.

- ii. Under USG- available is mentioned with reference to Annexure-15, but under annexure- 15; No mention of USG is made. Hence, availability of USG facility is not clear.
- iii. Following equipment is not available in College- In Department of Anatomy- Skeleton (Articulated) and Mummified bodies are not available. In Department of Physiology- Nil Auto analyzer or semi auto analyzer is available against 01 required, Nil Stethographs or pneumographs available against 05 required, Nil Electronic stop watches are available against 04 required, Nil Perimeter are available against 03 required, Nil Tonometer is available against 01 required. In Department of Biochemistry- Nil Double distillation glass apparatus is available against 01 required. In Department of Pathology- 02 Pathological specimens are available against 25 required. In Department of Pharmacy- 24 Water bath are available against 25 required.
- iv. Separate college website is not available.

4. In view of the above deficiencies, you are hereby given an opportunity of hearing in terms of the provisions of the first proviso to sub-section 4 of section 12A of the HCC Act, 1973 at **10.30 AM** on **26/07/2018** before the designated Hearing Committee in the Ministry of AYUSH to present your case and to show cause as to why the permission to Shree Swaminarayan Homoeopathy College, Shree Swaminarayan Vishwa Mangal Gurukul Trust, Nr. Ahmedabad-Mehsana National Highway, At & PO- Saij, Kalol, Dist. Gandhinagar- 382721, Gujarat to continue admission in BHMS course for the academic session 2018-19 should not be denied.

5. It is further directed that you may bring along and submit all possible oral and written submissions with valid documents/records/proof to substantiate your claims against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above during hearing for evidence/verifications by the Central Government.

6. It may please be also noted that in case you do not attend the hearing at the stipulated time and date, it will be presumed that you have nothing to say in the matter and necessary action will be taken based on available records as per the provisions of the HCC Act, 1973 and the relevant regulations made there under.
